It would be a shame to let this gift from the parish fail. A motion was made at the last membership meeting to return this source of income to the parish. The vote was split and the final decision fell upon me. I decided to continue with the bulletin for at least one more quarter, with a challenge to all of you to get out and sell some ads. The cost of printing the bulletin vs. the income that can be generated for the sale of ads warrants making this a priority. The other alternatives for raising fund are holding other events in the parish and community. This is not a bad alternative, and could even be a lot of fun, but it does require a lot more man hours from everyone. Not to say we will not strive to do more events and fund raisers in the future, I hope we will. But the selling of ads require a lot less man hours and leaves us more time for the events we have planned and to plan for future events. So please gentlemen let's get out and sell some ads. The costs of the ads are \$400 a year for a business card size ad or \$105 a quarter. Printing is done quarterly and ads can be changed each quarter. Billing is done quarterly but it should be encouraged to pay for a full year for the best savings. Also please contact Ken Wentz before you approach a business to insure we are not contacting them multiple times.

Finally I would like to thank Ken Wentz for taking care of the selling of the ads so far, also Bob Wentz for handling all the billing, and finally to Bob Sass for the outstanding work he has done in getting the ads placed on the bulletins and handling the printing. The three of them do a lot of work on this and do not get recognized nearly enough. Without them, this council would not be able to do the good works that we do.

And finally, October is the month of Mary and we will be saying the Rosary after each weekend Mass. There is a sign-up sheet in the narthex. Please signup to lead the Rosary and attend after Mass.
